The school development plan is our strategic approach in helping continually improve the quality of our provision at Brynllwarch Hall School

Inspection Area 1: Learning

1. Ensure that cross curricular skills are further developed to enable all learners to progress.
2. Continue to ensure learners are able to develop and gain skills in all areas of learning and in the wider community.
3. Provide further opportunities for learners to develop problem solving skills.
4. Ensure personalised assessment feedback is used to help inform target setting to drive further progress.

Inspection Area 4: Care Support and Guidance

1. Further implement the New ALN Act.
2. All staff trained and refreshed in PRICE behaviour management.
3. Support Powys with the transition from statements to IDPs.
4. Continue to update all staff with the ALN Act and associated training.
5. Continue to ensure IEP targets are bespoke and SMART for each learner to enable progress and skills development.

Inspection Area 2: Wellbeing and Attitudes to Learning

1. Continue to provide opportunities for learners to develop holistically and become resilient, life-long learners.
2. To become a UNICEF Rights Respecting school.
3. Continue to provide learners with opportunities to develop as confident, capable and resilient learners through offsite activities.
4. Continue to ensure learner voice is used to inform next steps.
5. Provide learners with further leadership roles and responsibilities that contribute to the work and life of the school.
6. Provide learners in KS4 and KS5 with opportunities to form and maintain links in their local community.
7. Maintain rigour around learner attendance.
8. Ensure staff are trained in trauma informed practice.

National Priorities

1. Improve pupils' progression by ensuring their learning is supported by a range of knowledge, skills and experience.
2. Reduce the impact of poverty on learners' progression and attainment.

Inspection Area 3: Teaching and Learning

1. Further implement the Curriculum for Wales with a focus on pedagogical approaches.
2. Ensure all learners have the opportunity to develop their Welsh language skills.
3. Ensure the continued progress and facilitation of the 4 core purposes for all learners.
4. All teaching to be judged good or better.
5. Ensure literacy remains a focus throughout all areas of learning.
6. Continue to review our curriculum offer to ensure it meets the needs and aspirations of our learners.

Inspection Area 5: Leadership and Management

1. Ensure leadership opportunities flourish with staff at all levels.
2. Share best practice across the sector in relation to BESD.
3. Ensure the development of the satellite provision is smooth to support BESD across Powys.
4. Ensure that the skillset of the staff team matches the ever changing needs of our learners.
5. Ensure that the new school is planned with a full contribution from all stakeholders.
