



Brynlywarch Hall School Improvement Priorities 2023 – 26.

The school development plan is our strategic approach in helping continually improve the quality of our provision at Brynlywarch Hall School

Inspection Area 1: Learning

1. Further drive literacy standards through catch up literacy, SPAG and guided reading sessions.
2. Continue to develop the use of Welsh and international languages throughout the school
3. Map out DCF teaching plan across the school, to ensure that pupils make good progress.
4. Provide a range of opportunities for pupils to develop their knowledge and understanding of RVE.
5. Further create opportunities for our learners to gain skills outside the classroom and in the wider community.
6. To implement the rapid Maths scheme to raise learner attainment and confidence in maths.

Inspection Area 4: Care Support and Guidance

1. Further implement the New ALN Act.
2. All staff trained and refreshed in PRICE behaviour management.
3. Ensure that all teaching staff can use *Tyfu* as a tool to identify pupils' needs and best ways of supporting them.
4. Continue to update all staff with the ALN Act and associated training.
5. Update the Pupil Information File (PIF) to include relevant information from the IDP.
6. Continue to ensure IEP targets are bespoke and SMART for each learner to enable progress and skills development.

Inspection Area 2: Wellbeing and Attitudes to Learning

1. Further develop and strengthen school engagement with families to enhance outcomes for learners.
 2. Further strengthen the school's approach to supporting mental health and wellbeing for learners and staff.
3. Continue to provide learners with opportunities to develop as confident, capable and resilient learners through offsite activities.
 4. Maintain rigour around learner attendance.
5. Provide learners with further leadership roles and responsibilities that contribute to the work and life of the school.
6. Ensure staff are trained in trauma informed practice.

National Priorities

1. Improve pupils' progression by ensuring their learning is supported by a range of knowledge, skills and experience.
2. Reduce the impact of poverty on learners' progression and attainment.

Inspection Area 3: Teaching and Learning

1. To develop a strong understanding of the pedagogical principles and employ a range of strategies within the classroom to ensure pupils make good progress.
2. Further develop the school's assessment procedures ensuring that learners are aware of their next steps and have opportunities to input into their learning.
3. Continue to work closely with other stakeholders in quality assurance around teaching and learning.
 4. All teaching to be judged good or better.
5. Continue to review our curriculum offer to ensure it meets the needs and aspirations of our learners.

Inspection Area 5: Leadership and Management

1. Our ALENCO supports ALENCO's throughout Powys in her role as ALENCO Champion.
 2. Support the behaviour consultation programme throughout Powys.
3. Ensure that the satellite in Ystradgynlais is supported to become a centre of excellence that can fully support the South of the authority.
4. Ensure that the skillset of the staff team matches the ever-changing needs of our learners.
 5. Ensure that the new school is planned with a full contribution from all stakeholders.
